Tip of the Month by Vu Nguyen

Positioning of the Net Player in Doubles

In doubles, both the baseline and the net player have crucial roles that determine the outcome of each point. In this edition of "Tip of the Month", we will discuss the role of the net player and how they may change their positioning at the net to become a more involved and effective partner!

In recreational doubles, the server's partner typically stands at the net in order to take advantage of a weak return. A very common mistake that is made is that the net player will stand too close to the net in an attempt to be extra aggressive. The only problem with this position is that at the 3.0-4.0 levels many returns are hit high or as lobs. This then takes the net player out of the picture. A more effective position for the server's partner is to start halfway in the service box. From this position they may then be in position to take a high volley or an overhead if the return is a lob. They may also move forward to hit a volley if the return is shorter or lower to the net.

This simple adjustment in positioning will allow the server's partner to become more active and be able to play more shots!
